Detailed description of the key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Nepal Limited (CRNL) has withdrawn the rating of "CARE-NP B+; ISSUER NOT COOPERATING*" assigned to the bank facilities of Him Parbat Hydropower Limited (HPHL) with immediate effect as HPHL failed to provide information for monitoring of the ratings. In line with the extant of Securities Board of Nepal (SEBON) guidelines, CRNL has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information and kept the rating on Notice of Withdrawal for six months which however, in CRNL's opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating. Therefore, after the monitoring of the ratings for six months there is no cooperation from the Issuer, accordingly CRNL has withdrawn the ratings.

Users of this ratings (including investors, lenders and the public at large) are hence requested to exercise caution while using the above ratings.

About the Company

Him Parbat Hydropower Private Limited was incorporated on June 11, 2014 as a private limited company which was later converted into public limited company as Him Parbat Hydropower Limited (HPHL) on June 13, 2021. It is promoted by individual promoters and institutional investors for setting up of a 20 MW run-of-river, Sagu Khola Hydropower Project (SKHP) and 5.5 MW run of river Sagu Khola1 Hydropower Project (SK1HP) in "BOOT" (Build, Own, Operate and transfer) model in Bigu Rural Municipality, Dolakha district of Nepal.
