Detailed description of the key rating drivers

CARE Ratings Nepal Limited (CRNL) has withdrawn the ratings of "CARE-NP BB-; ISSUER NOT COOPERATING*" and "CARE-NP A4; ISSUER NOT COOPERATING*" assigned to the bank facilities of Singha & Brothers Construction Private Limited (SBCP) with immediate effect as SBCP had failed to provide information for monitoring of the ratings. In line with the extant of Securities Board of Nepal (SEBON) guidelines, CRNL has reviewed the rating on the basis of the best available information and kept the rating on Notice of Withdrawal for six months which however, in CRNL's opinion is not sufficient to arrive at a fair rating. Therefore, after the monitoring of the ratings for six months there is no cooperation from the Issuer, accordingly CRNL has withdrawn the ratings.

Users of this ratings (including investors, lenders and the public at large) are hence requested to exercise caution while using the above ratings.

SBCP, incorporated on April 21, 2003, is a construction company of Nepal with registered office based in Kathmandu, Nepal. The company is engaged in construction and infrastructure sector undertaking projects of roads and civil construction on engineering, procurement and construction (EPC) basis.
